Anzac Parade Pavement Reconstruction Stages 1 & 2

Projected Project completion date: April 2010

Overall value of project: \$4.0m

Location: Both Carriageways of Anzac Parade (between Fairbairn Ave and Constitution Ave)

Client: National Capital Authority

Contract type: Lump Sum



Scope: The scope of work included a full depth pavement reconstruction of both sides of Anzac Parade between Fairbairn Ave and Constitution Ave. The length of the works is approximately 880m long. In addition to the pavement reconstruction, new kerbs, stormwater structures, subsoil drains and associated landscaping works were constructed. Because Anzac Parade is the main ceremonial road in Canberra there were very strict timelines in which the works could be completed. The works were carried out in two stages between November and April in two successive years.
